"I want to grow up" – with this appeal children of kindergarten "Rakovina" in Burgas together with volunteers from Bulgarian Red Cross were giving away balloons and preventive materials to participants in the road traffic after stopping it in both ways of boulevard "Hristo Botev" by the Road police.
