On 19 June 2015 in Kavala, Greece a final meeting on the project "Culture Exchange Platform in the Black Sea Basin" (CULTUR-EXP) was held implemented within the framework of the Joint Operational Programme "Black Sea Basin" 2007-2013. Representatives of all partnership organizations took part in the meeting - Georgian Research and Educational Networking Association (GRENA) – Leading project partner, Bourgas Regional Administration, European Regional Framework for Co-operation (ERFC), AMAP Human Development NGO, Research and Educational Networking Association of Moldova (RENAM). In the final meeting the work of the project teams was presented and the Culture Exchange Platform's future development was discussed.

The overall objective of the project is to provide an innovative, multi-lingual IT platform, based on available open source social platform solutions and adapted for culture producers (artists, directors or art, festival organizers), culture operators (museums, festivals, etc.) and other actors of the culture market. The platform will be an online tool, where all cultural professional and organisations in the Black Sea region will be able to advertise, discuss and organize cultural activities and events. The platform will also be an important source of information about the culture and related cultural events (artists, operators, events) for art lovers and culture consumers.
