The first edition of the Lifelong Learning National Days 2015 brought together over 300 educational experts, teachers, school principals, representatives of the business circles, of local authorities, of NGOs throughout the country and foreign guests in Burgas.

The three-day forum in Burgas offered a series of events related to lifelong learning – conferences, presentations, exchange of good practices, exhibition of schools and educational institutions for adults.
